Present: Mayor Krutzfeldt, Council Members Burnett, Moore and Ottosson, Absent: Caligiuri, Walling and Yates. None. Staff in attendance: Michael Schrock, Akhilesh Pal and Sean Murphy.

The meeting called to order at 6:30 PM.

Discussion Of Possible Road Improvement Options For The Meadow Creek Subdivision

Staff provided a presentation and update on project options for the Meadow Creek Subdivision. This meeting was scheduled following the council budget meeting where a similar presentation was made by staff. The project is not presently funded for construction in the city's 5-year plan as cost estimates are approximately \$1.8 million to fully reconstruct. Staff and the neighborhood discussed construction options (width, road type), sidewalks, street trees, and other concerns. Members of the neighborhood expressed a desire to have the road reconstructed the same way it was approximately 30 years ago, concrete, full width, no sidewalks, no trees. Staff is proposing a reduced width road, concrete, additional subdrains and surface drainage, sidewalks, and street trees. The neighborhood would like the improvements to occur as soon as possible. Issuance of debt and property tax increases were discussed as a possibility. Assessments are an option but would not be recommended for road improvements, curb, or gutter. Staff stated this project would be discussed during the FY2020 budget process in the fall.
