MINUTES OF OSKALOOSA HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
September 19, 2011

A special meeting of the Historic Preservation board for the City of Oskaloosa was called to order at 4:30 p.m. on Monday September 19, 2011 by Chairperson J.Todd Roach, at Hawkeye Real Estate 121 High Avenue East.

COMMITTEE MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairperson J. Todd Roach, James Hansen, Aimee O'Brien, Jeff Sisul and Jo Broerman. COMMITTEE MEMBERS ABSENT: Julie Hansen; CITY STAFF PRESENT: City Engineer Akhilesh Pal, Building Official Dan Bolt and Water Department Representative Chad Coon.

The first item discussed was the Water Department representative Chad Coon presented plans for facade and landscape modifications at 213 South 1st Street, to include removal of an ironwork balcony at the second floor level, removal of plantings and display of Clow fire hydrants painted in a patriotic theme, and moving of a flagpole to a more central position. Hansen moved approval with the pending further consideration of options concerning the removal of balcony as it would leave a door without balcony Broerman seconded. *YES:* Hansen, O'Brien, Sisul and Broerman. *NO:* None. *ABSENT:* Julie Hansen.

The second item discussed was the signage at 120 North 1st Street. After discussion of the signage at 120 North 1st Street, Chairperson Roach tabled the item for consideration after more information is available as to acceptable sign designs for similar business and consideration of what other communities may have found appropriate. A meeting was tentatively scheduled for October 12, 2011 for purpose of further consideration.

With no further business, Chairperson Roach adjourned the meeting at 5:05 pm.
