AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF OSKALOOSA, IOWA BY AMENDING THE PROVISIONS SECTION 12.12.140 TO CLARIFY THE EXPENSES ASSESSED FOR CLEANING OF SNOW AND ICE ACCUMULATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Oskaloosa, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section 12.12.140 Cleaning snow, ice and accumulations is amended by deleting the fourth sentence therefrom and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

These costs, together with the administrative expenses of the City in connection therewith as determined by the City Manager, shall be assessed to the property as taxes.

## ORDINANCE NO. 1285

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF OSKALOOSA, IOWA BY AMENDING THE PROVISIONS SECTION 5.04.350 RELATIVE TO PERSONS UNDER THE LEGAL AGE.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Oskaloosa, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section 5.04.350 is amended by deleting the current section, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5.04.350 Persons under legal age - Penalty:

1. A person shall not sell, give, or otherwise supply alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer to any person knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that person to be under legal age.
2. A person or persons under legal age shall not purchase or attempt to purchase, or individually or jointly have alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer in their possession or control; except in the case of liquor, wine or beer given or dispensed to a person under legal age within a private home and with the knowledge, presence, and consent of the parent or guardian, for beverage or medicinal purposes or as administered to the person by either a physician or dentist for medicinal purposes and except to the extent that a person under legal age may handle alcoholic beverages, wine, and beer during the regular course of the person's employment by a liquor control licensee, or wine or beer permittee under this chapter.
3. A person who is under legal age, other than as licensee or permittee, who violates this section regarding the purchase of or attempt to purchase alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer, or possessing or having control of alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer, commits a simple misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This amendment to the ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication by law.

9.16.030 Drug paraphernalia: Section 124.414 of the Code of Iowa relative to drug paraphernalia is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF OSKALOOSA, IOWA BY AMENDING THE PROVISIONS CHAPTER 10.08 TO ADOPT AND INCORPORATE BY REFERENCE PROVISIONS OF THE CODE OF IOWA RELATIVE TO SCHEDULED VIOLATION PENALTIES.

## ORDINANCE NO. 1289

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF OSKALOOSA,  
IOWA BY CHANGING THE ZONING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED AT 701 &  
707 SOUTH C STREET FROM R-2, URBAN FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT, TO  
LI, LIMITED INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT**

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Oskaloosa, Iowa that:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to change the zoning of the following described parcels of land from R-2, Urban Family Residential District to LI, Limited Industrial District, legally described as follows:

The surface only of Lot One of Block Eleven of Montgomery's Second Addition to the City of Oskaloosa, Iowa

Lots Four and Five of Block Eleven of Montgomery's Second Addition to the City of Oskaloosa, Iowa

Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 5, Block 11, in Montgomery's 2<sup>nd</sup> Addition, thence south 35 feet; thence west 136.5 feet; thence north 35 feet; thence east 136.5 feet to the point of beginning in the City of Oskaloosa, Iowa

Commencing at the northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 11, in Montgomery's 2<sup>nd</sup> Addition, thence west 16.5 feet to northeast corner of Lot 2 of said addition; thence south 160.5 feet to the southeast corner of Lot 6 of said addition; thence east 16.5 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 5 of said addition; thence north 160.5 feet to the point of beginning in the City of Oskaloosa, Iowa

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication by law.
