1. All work will be done according to attached drawings and the application.
2. This Certificate is only to:
  - a. Install a new 3'x6' sign on the front of the building. The sign color is a white background with red and black lettering attached to an existing aluminum frame.
3. The building improvements within the zoning jurisdiction of the city must comply with the provisions of this chapter 15, *Buildings and Construction*, other relevant provisions of the Oskaloosa Municipal Code, and applicable building codes.
4. All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within twelve months of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
5. If permits are required, you are responsible for obtaining them from the City of Oskaloosa Building Inspector, who can be reached at 641-673-7472.
