Item Title:

Consider an ordinance amending Oskaloosa Municipal Code Chapter 10.24 – “Stop and Yield Requirements” – 1st Reading.

Explanation:

Staff is proposing new stop signs to facilitate the ongoing subdivision developments at the Marje Addition. The proposed stop signs are intended to improve traffic flow and safety as these areas are being developed. Installation of new stop signs requires changes to the Oskaloosa Municipal Code. The locations of the new stop signs are listed as follows:

- Stop sign for the eastbound vehicles at the intersection of 18th Avenue East & South 5th Street.
- Stop sign for the westbound vehicles at the intersection of 18th Avenue East & Greenbelt Drive.

Recommended Action:

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the 1st reading of the ordinance as presented.

Budget Consideration:

Minimal financial costs are associated with updates to the Oskaloosa Municipal Code. The cost of materials for each new stop sign is approximately \$150. The City will be responsible to install the new stop sign at the locations listed above.
