SPECIAL MEETING  
January 18, 2021

The Oskaloosa City Council met in special session on Monday, January 18, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. via electronic meeting in accordance with the State Public Health Emergency Declaration issued by the Governor of the State of Iowa with Mayor Krutzfeldt presiding and the following members answering roll call: Burnett, Caligiuri, Drost, Moore, Ottosson, Walling and Yates. Absent: None.

It was moved by Caligiuri, seconded by Yates to approve the January 18, 2021 agenda. The roll was called and the vote was:

Whereupon the Mayor declared said motion approved.

City Manager, Michael Schrock Jr. gave a presentation on the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget Amendment and Fiscal Year 2022 Proposed Budget.

It was moved by Moore, seconded by Caligiuri to contribute \$75,000 to the Stephen Memorial Animal Shelter for operating expenses and reserve for FY22. The roll was called and the vote was:

Whereupon the Mayor declared said motion approved.

It was moved by Moore, seconded by Caligiuri to contribute \$45,000 to the Oskaloosa Chamber for FY22. The roll was called and the vote was:

Whereupon the Mayor declared said motion approved.

It was moved by Moore, seconded by Caligiuri to contribute \$95,000 to Forest Cemetery for FY22. The roll was called and the vote was:

Whereupon the Mayor declared said motion approved.

It was moved by Moore, seconded by Caligiuri to contribute \$10,000 to the 10-15 Transit (Osby Rides) for FY22. The roll was called and the vote was:

NAYS: None

Whereupon the Mayor declared said motion approved.

City Council discussed the proposed amendment to FY2021 budget and the proposed FY2022 budget and tax levy.

It was moved by Drost, seconded by Moore that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 5:57 p.m.
