

OSKALOOSA CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
January 21, 2019

The Oskaloosa City Council met in special session on Monday, January 21, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. with Mayor Krutzfeldt presiding and the following members answering roll call: Caligiuri, Drost, Ottosson, Walling and Yates. Moore joined the meeting at 1:02 p.m. Absent: Burnett.

It was moved by Yates, seconded by Drost to approve the January 21, 2019 agenda. The roll was called and the vote was:

AYES: Caligiuri, Drost, Ottosson, Walling and Yates

NAYS: None

Whereupon the Mayor declared said motion approved.

Council Member Moore entered the meeting.

City Manager, Michael Schrock Jr. gave a presentation on the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget Amendment and Fiscal Year 2020 Proposed Budget.

Council proposed a contribution in the amount of \$50,000 to the Oskaloosa Chamber, \$100,000 to Forest Cemetery, \$10,000 to the 10-15 Transit (Oskey Rides) and \$85,000 to the Stephen Memorial Animal Shelter for operating expenses and reserve for FY20. Council proposed budgeting \$30,000 for the fifth payment of a five (5) year contribution for a total of \$150,000 which could be used towards the new animal shelter facility.

City Council discussed the proposed amendment to FY2019 budget and the proposed FY2020 budget and tax levy.

It was moved by Yates, seconded by Moore that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 6:51 p.m.
