

Study Session Minutes - Oskaloosa City Council
Monday, April 5, 2021

Present: Mayor Krutzfeldt; Council Members Burnett, Caligiuri, Drost, Moore, Ottosson, Walling, and Yates. Absent: None. Staff in attendance: Miller, Schrock, and Christ.

1. Discussion of FY2022 Budget and Infrastructure Projects. The city council received presentations and discussed capital projects that could be tied to future federal stimulus funds that are anticipated to be received by the city. The amount expected in the first round of funds is approximately \$1.95 million with a 2024 expenditure deadline (subject to change once final rules issued by Treasury). Limited information for eligible uses available at the time, but water, sewer, and broadband expansion appear to be acceptable. Staff shared project options that include additional infrastructure in the form of roads and parking lots. If not eligible this time around, perhaps the second phase of stimulus would include pavement improvements.

Consensus of council was to have city staff review current funding sources, capital improvement planning documents, and begin to organize the plan with the anticipation of receiving stimulus funds – present options during a future meeting, or during the budgeting process.
