

MINUTES  
OSKALOOSA AIRPORT COMMISSION

May 6, 2019

Meeting of the Oskaloosa Airport Commission was called to order at 4:32 p.m. on Monday, May 6, 2019.

1. ROLL CALL: Roll was taken with the following present: Steve Brown, Kraig Van Hulzen, James Johnson, Larry Lewis, and Jerry Strunk [Midwest Aviation].
2. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: Moved by Kraig Van Hulzen and seconded by Larry Lewis to approve the minutes of the April 1, 2019 meeting. Motion carried.
3. FINANCIAL REPORT: Moved by Larry Lewis and seconded by James Johnson to approve the financial report. Motion carried.
4. REVIEW AND APPROVE BILLS: Moved by Larry Lewis and seconded by James Johnson to pay bills totaling \$980.07. Motion carried.
5. MANAGER'S REPORT: See attached.
6. OLD BUSINESS:
  - a. Runway 4/22 project: No action was taken.
  - b. Fixed base operator: City Manager Michael Schrock has determined that we are not legally required to advertise for bids. We will continue to negotiate with Shane Vande Voort of Classic Aviation, Inc.
  - c. Storm shelter: The doors have not been installed yet.
  - d. Pest control: Received an unsolicited bid from A+ Quality Pest Control for \$50.00 a month and would add treating the corporate hangar for an additional \$30.00. There was no guarantee how long this price could be maintained. Certified Pest Control has offered a three year contract to provide treatment for \$105.00 a month and includes the corporate hangar. They are currently charging \$105.00, but this does not include the corporate hangar. Kraig Van Hulzen moved to accept the contract with Certified Pest Control. James Johnson seconded. Motion carried.
7. NEW BUSINESS:
  - a. Spraying for weeds: Allied Gas and Chemical has been spraying the runway and ramp, but the treatment does not seem to last very long. DeJong Landscaping has been spraying along the roadway. Jerry Strunk will talk to them about spraying the runway and ramp. He will see if they have any type of treatment that will last longer.
  - b. Soil testing: Kraig Van Hulzen will have soil testing scheduled this fall.
  - c. Sweeping ramp: Jerry Strunk reported that City personnel came out and swept the ramp per his request.
  - d. June meeting date: The date of Monday, June 3rd was acceptable to everyone.
8. Adjourn: It was moved by Larry Lewis to adjourn at 5:07 p.m. Kraig Van Hulzen seconded. Motion carried.
