Consider an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for 124 South 1st Street.

FACE (Fine Arts & Cultural Events) of Mahaska County, has applied for a COA to paint a 15'x20' mural on the north exterior wall of MidWest One Bank. It is attended to look like old sheet music. The mural will be put on an aluminum panel as the original brick on the building is too rough to be painted on. By putting the mural on an aluminum panel, it will add a more vibrance look, as it will reflect light better.
